Short drives will take you to see historic Berry, the “town of trees”; the Coolangatta Historic Village Resort and Winery.


Kangaroo Valley and Nowra are other places of interest to visit for shopping or a welcome coffee or meal stop.

## *THE SHACK*

A complex of six two bedroom holiday units located at Shoalhaven Heads on the NSW South Coast. The units are an Apex/Community project and were built mostly by voluntary workers using money donated by Apex clubs and community organisations, businesses and individuals. The Governor of NSW, Rear Admiral Peter Sinclair AC AO, officially opened the units on 12 July 1992.

Each unit comprises two bedrooms, bathroom (suitable for wheelchair access), kitchen and living/dining areas. There is sleeping accommodation for six people, with cots and high chairs available. The kitchen is fully equipped. The living room has colour TV and an extensive library of children's books. The outdoor furniture can be used on your private rear patio or around the barbecue.

There are six parking spaces in the courtyard area and two visitor spaces at the front. The carport areas can be used as play areas for the children during inclement weather.

The laundry is equipped with two washing machines and one clothes dryer. A blue pay phone is available for guests.

Shoalhaven Heads is a popular tourist destination on the South Coast of New South Wales. The Shack is located in the village just 200 metres from the beach, which is good for fishing and swimming. Swimming between the flags near the surf life saving club is recommended.

The council pool is about 400 metres from the SHACK and is excellent for small children; there is a hoist available at the pool for disabled people.

The river forms the southern boundary of the village and is good for boating, fishing and other water sports including sailboarding.

Seven Mile Beach National Park has wheelchair access and paths which make it a great place to walk through and take in the fresh air and beautiful scenery.
